#### **1. Which categories are open to international participants?**

- This competition is open to all Malaysians, students and teachers under the Ministry of Education and International participants except those from countries listed in United Nations Security Council Sanctions through this website <https://www.un.org/securitycouncil/sanctions/information>

#### **3. How can I register for Petrosains RBTX Challenge 2024?**
